The 11th renewal of Alabama's premier end-of-season tournament for junior varsity squads will be played on April 22, 23, and 24 on the campus of Huntsville High School.

Supercup provides JV teams an intense weekend of competitive soccer much like the post-season playoff conditions they will face in future years. This year's tournament promises to be one of the most competitive ever. The women's bracket features the JV squads from five high schools that finished last year's varsity campaigns ranked in the final 6A top-10 as well as the final #3 and #4 ranked 5A schools. The men's side also features five top-10 6A schools as well as the #4 and #7 ranked 5A schools.
